



North Dakota Fish Cleaning Stations

The North Dakota Game and Fish Department has installed fish cleaning stations at many waters throughout the state to provide more public fishing opportunities. Cleaning stations at most waters in the list below meet Americans with Disabilities Act requirements although the route or path from the designated parking area to the cleaning station may not meet specific handicap requirements because of the type of surface, slope, and terrain. In almost all cases, persons with a disability can easily access the cleaning station with assistance from another individual.

Lake Ashtabula - Sibley Crossing: 23.5 miles north of Valley City

Lake Ashtabula - Ashtabula Crossing: 16.5 miles north of Valley City

Lake Metigoshe: 9 miles north, 4 miles east, 1 mile north of Bottineau

Short Creek Dam: 5.5 miles north of Columbus

Smishek Lake: 4 miles northwest of Powers Lake

Mount Carmel Dam: 9 miles north, 2 miles east, 2 miles north of Langdon

Heart Butte Reservoir - North Shore: 16.6 miles south on ND HWY 49, .3 miles west of Glen Ullin

McIntosh

Green Lake: 2 miles east, 4 miles south, 1 mile east of Wishek

Lake Hoskins: 3 miles west of Ashley

McLean

Lake Audubon - Totten Trail: 6 miles north on US HWY 83, .2 miles east, .3 miles south of Coleharbor

East Park Lake: 9 miles south of Mercer

Lightning Lake: .5 miles east of Turtle Lake

Stump Lake - Tolna Landing (Stump Lake): 3 miles north of Tolna.

Stump Lake - Stump Lake Park: 11 miles south, 1 mile west of Lakota.

Devils Lake - Minnewaukan City: Eastside of the city of Minnewaukan

Devils Lake - Grahams Island State Park: 10 miles west of Devils Lake on ND Highway 19, then 6 miles south.

Devils Lake - Schwab Landing: 7 miles west of Devils Lake on ND Highway 19.

Devils Lake - Creel Bay: 3 miles south of Devils Lake on ND Highway 20, then 2 miles west and .25 miles north.

Devils Lake - Henegar Landing: 1 mile west of Devils Lake on ND Highway 19, then .75 miles south.

Knife River: In Dunn and Mercer counties

Missouri River - Garrison Dam Tailrace: Directly below Garrison Dam.

Missouri River - Washburn: On east side of the Missouri River near Washburn, north of ND Highway 200A bridge.

Missouri River - Kniefel (Misty Waters) Landing: On east side of the Missouri River near Bismarck, 3 miles north of I-94 bridge on River Road, then 1 mile west.

Missouri River - Fox Island Park: From Washington Street, .75 miles west on Riverwood Drive (1 block south of Expressway), 1.5 miles south and .5 miles west.

Missouri River - Graner Bottoms (Sugar Loaf): 19 miles south of Mandan on ND Highway 1806, then 1 mile east, or about 3 miles north of Huff.

Lake Oahe - Fort Rice: 28 miles south of Mandan on ND Highway 1806, then .5 miles east.

Lake Oahe - Prairie Knights Marina: 10 miles south of the Cannonball River on ND Highway 1806, then 3.5 miles east.

Lake Oahe - Beaver Bay: 13 miles west of Linton on ND Highway 13, then 2 miles south on ND Highway 1804.

Lake Oahe - Langeliers Bay: 10 miles west of Strasburg, 1 mile south, 7 miles west, then 11 miles south on ND Highway 1804, and .75 miles west.

Red River - Kidder Recreation Area: North edge of Wahpeton.

Red River - Drayton Dam: 2 miles north, 1 mile east of Drayton.

Red River - Pembina City Park: East side of Pembina.

Lake Sakakawea - Lewis And Clark State Park: 16 miles east of Williston on ND Highway 1804, then 3 miles south.

Lake Sakakawea - Tobacco Garden Creek Bay: 2 miles east of Watford City on ND Highway 23, then 25 miles north and east on ND Highway 1806.

Lake Sakakawea - Little Beaver Bay: 32 miles northwest of New Town on ND Highway 1804, then 3 miles south.

Lake Sakakawea - White Earth Bay: 28 miles northwest of New Town on ND Highway 1804, then 2 miles south, 1 mile east, 3 miles south, 3 miles east.

Lake Sakakawea - New Town Marina: 2 miles west of New Town on ND Highway 23.

Lake Sakakawea - Four Bears: 4 miles west of New Town on ND Highway 23.

Lake Sakakawea - Skunk Bay: 14 miles northeast of Mandaree.

Lake Sakakawea - Van Hook: 5 miles east of New Town on ND Highway 23, then 2 miles south.

Lake Sakakawea - Van Hook: 5 miles east of New Town on ND Highway 23, then 2 miles south.

Lake Sakakawea - Parshall Bay: 3 miles west, 1 mile south, 3 miles west, 1 mile south, 2 miles west of Parshall.

Lake Sakakawea - McKenzie Bay: 22 miles southeast of Mandaree.

Lake Sakakawea - Charging Eagle Bay: 12 miles north of Halliday on ND Highway 8, then 10 miles west on BIA No. 22.

Lake Sakakawea - Indian Hills Resort: 11 miles west of White Shield on ND Highway 1804, then 3 miles south.

Lake Sakakawea - Dakota Waters Resort: 15 miles north of Beulah.

Lake Sakakawea - Beulah Bay: 17 miles north of Beulah.

Lake Sakakawea - Hazen Bay: 14 miles north of Hazen.

Lake Sakakawea - Lake Sakakawea State Park: Just east and north of Pick City.

Lake Sakakawea - Fort Stevenson State Park: 3 miles south of Garrison.

Lake Sakakawea - Sportsmens Centennial Park: 1 mile west of the junction of ND Highway 37 and U.S. Highway 83, then 2 miles south, 1 mile west.

Lake Sakakawea - Wolf Creek: 1 mile east of Riverdale on ND Highway 200, then 2 miles north, 1 mile east, 1 mile north, .5 miles east.

Lake Sakakawea - Government Bay: Just north of Riverdale.

Souris River (Mouse River) - Mouse River Park: 3 miles north, 1.5 miles northeast of Tolley

Jamestown Reservoir - Marina Area: 2 miles north on ND Highway 20, .5 miles southwest of Jamestown

Homme Dam: 2 miles west of Park River

Blacktail Dam: 5 miles north, 5 miles west, 1 mile north of the junction of U.S. highways 2 and 85
